

1) Granular control of services displayed in Chatbot.




2) Payments through bot enabled. If service is displayed in chatbot now there is an option to take payments through the bot for that service. Users if they have an email address defined will get a receipt automatically sent. You will need to have Stripe integration turned on for this to work.


If a patient cancels after paying the practice will be alerted through the ToDos that a refund is required.



3) When booking through admin panel there is now the option to not send notifications when booking appointments.




4) Option to quickly have a video consultation for any consultation type




5) Video Consultation – Patient Waiting Room

There is now a pop-up alert when a patient enters the video consultation waiting room. This allows you to quickly enter the video consultation or can be closed until such time as you are ready for consultation.



6) Email Invoices and Receipts

Option to email invoices and receipts. Self-service option will be available for patients through the bot in the coming weeks. Patient can select time period: receipts; outstanding invoices will be sent to them automatically. Patients will need email address defined in the system for this functionality to work.




7) Add practice T&Cs and Privacy statement to Chatbot

Set in practice details. Set none, one or both.




8) Set User Calendar Preferences

9) New Patients

When a new patient registers through the Chatbot there is now a notification added to the ToDo.
